Medium: Mixed Media

Skill Level: All

Student Supply List:

6 – 8 x 10 flat canvas panels

One dozen – 4 x 6 colored photographs that can be painted over

(use any snapshots you have lying around)

2 – 8 x 10 black and white photographs printed on matte paper (not glossy) for hand-coloring

Inexpensive basic set of brushes that can be used for acrylic and watercolor paint

Mixed media pad -size 9 x 12 (Strathmore makes a 15-sheet pad that works well)

4 – 8 x 10 Xerox (toner) copies of high contrast images

(black and white with areas of pure white and black work best)

4 – 5 x 7 Xerox (toner) copies of high contrast images

(black and white with areas of pure white and black work best)

Bring some photographs* for discussion so that you can learn what types of images work with the art you create

*(please bring prints, if you have them, or images on your cell phone)

Plastic cups for medium and water (two or three 12 oz. cups will suffice)
